

PRIORITY IN ADMISSIONS

ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-27 onwards


- The academic year shall begin on 1st April, each year.

- Fee Structure is provided in a separate sheet.
- Fees can be paid quarterly (by 10th April, 10th July, 10th Oct, 10th Jan)
- Mode of Payments are Cash / Pay Order / Credit Card / Debit Card / UPI.
- Fees can be paid either at the Fee counter, or on the online fees portal, except for the first instalment while taking admission, which must be paid only at the fees counter.
- There will be 7.25% Yearly Hike in School Fees and Bus Fees, every Year.



CLASSROOMS


- Every classroom is equipped with SMART BOARDS, ample Lighting, Spacious

CBSE EXAMINAITONS

- Normally, CBSE conducts board exams of Grade-X & XII in the Month of February & March every year.
- Normally, exam centre for CBSE board exams are allotted in the home school only. Or alternatively, any CBSE school in Mira-Bhayander area.
- Learners are graded on a 5 point scale from A to E in Extra-curricular. It does not affect their academic grades.
- o In class XII, learners can choose Physical Education as an elective syllabus title.
- o In class IX to XII, learners can opt for multiple other subjects if they wish to, provided they manage the learning on their own, and registered by school.







CBSE ADMISSOIN DATES

- Starts from 5th Day after Diwali (Laabh Panchami). However, the admission commencement date varies each year.
- Admission process ends when all seats are filled, or on 31st August, whichever is earlier.

MEALS FOR STUDENTS


- o The school does not provide food in the classroom.



Additional Benefits of Tuff Club Sports Activities:


These sports activities provide an excellent opportunity for students to prepare for district, state, and national-level competitions, with the potential to progress to the Olympic level.




